NB07-0912 NB Inspection Guides Part 2 Section 5 Review National Board Inspection Guides for Cast Iron Boilers, PRDs, Water Level Controls & Devices and Operating Controls. The Task Groups assigned to review National Board Inspection Guides gave reports as follows:

Guide for Cast Iron Boilers – The work of this Task Group was approved during the July 2008 meeting.

Guide for PRD – Task Group J. Richardson and R. Wacker.

NB08-0321 Part 2 1.5 SG Inspection Specific Add in paragraph 1.5 Inspection Activities wording to address change of service for a pressure vessel. These requirements should caution inspectors, owners, and jurisdictional authorities of the inherent dangers involved when changing service. A new supplement or new Subject under 2.3.6, descriptions and Concerns of Specific Types of Pressure Vessels, should be added to address the specific requirements for inspection of pressure vessels that have been converted

from one service to another. The Task Group is comprised of G. McRae (Lead), B. Reetz, R. Wacker, D. Cook, and J. Getter.
